The **Challenge of the Week** is an online only weekly quiz hosted on the [Circ EP website](#). The questions will rotate between the categories (i) *ECG*, (ii) *intracardiac electrogram*, (iii) *clinical* and (iv) *device*. The questions/answers will be archived online and referenced by the author(s) name, publication date and weblink. Submissions should be worthy of challenging the astute student of electrophysiology. Each question/answer will undergo a review process for selection. If your submission is chosen, the section editors may make modifications or ask for changes to fit the publication style and/or highlight teaching points.

Instructions for submission:

- Participants will choose one of the categories referenced above, provide author names, degrees, affiliations, and list any conflicts of interest.
- A maximum of two authors per submission will be considered.
- Challenge questions should be submitted using the [powerpoint template](#) and should include the following:
 - A succinctly worded question with 1-2 figures/tracings, if needed. The information in the question should be sufficient and non-conflicting to allow an unambiguous answer.
 - Five (5) clearly specified answer choices with a single correct answer.
 - The figures/tracings should be high-resolution publication quality and should be clearly labeled, if applicable.
 - If figures/tracings are included, they should be your own unpublished non-copyrighted material(s) or you must provide written permission for use with acknowledgment of the same.
- A clearly worded explanation for the answer which highlights the teaching points must be provided as well as any references to the material.
